This boat yard, on the Ashton Canal in the suburb of Audenshaw has a 2ft line originally used when the canal basin was being excavated & is now used for moving equipment [& at times narrowboats].

The yard is one of the few working 2ft industrial lines remaining in the UK although it is not used every day.

The mainline is about 700ft long with a number of spurs.

Two HE diesels & a small RH are expected to be active & there are other locos on site.
