The 2ft line was originally laid down to aid with muck-removal from a large number of egg production sheds but this operation is now closed and the site developed as a Rural Museum with attractions that include a 2ft gauge railway.

We are having a private visit and are promised up to five diesels working, with passenger & engineering trains and other 'special operations' although sadly the 'steam tram' is OOU awaiting a new boiler. Driving was offered on our 2018 visit.

Although the visit will concentrate on the NG line, other items at the museum are expected to be available for inspection. The museum's website has drone footage showing the attractive line.
