The line is noted for fast running in a wooded location with an interesting tunnel and a splendid viaduct. Recently part of the original mainline has been relaid. Recent timber-felling has opened new vistas across the Medway valley.

There should be at least two locomotives in steam and hopefully visiting steam from the nearby Brogdale Railway near Faversham, one of the few other 9" lines.
