Membership renewal for year ending

We hope that you enjoy being a member of the Society and that you will renew your membership for the coming year. Your current membership expires on 1 April 2022 and is now due for renewal. If you joined the Society since 1 January 2022 your membership runs until 31 March 2023 so no action is required.

We appreciate that there are financial pressures on discretionary spending, so for the fourth year running **there is no change to the annual subscription rates**. We do believe, however, that the Society offers good value for money and we appreciate your ongoing support.

You may purchase Associate and/or Visits & e-NGN memberships along with your subscription renewal.

Full memberships receive printed copies of The Narrow Gauge and six issues of Narrow Gauge News together with any special issue books published by the Society. Other members of a family household may become **Associate members** enabling them to come with you on Society visits to narrow gauge railways, the AGM and visit the Society library at Apedale. Associate memberships do not receive any publications.

E-memberships will receive Narrow Gauge News electronically along with printed copies of The Narrow Gauge and any special issue books.

Visits & e-NGN memberships are eligible for Society visits and will receive Narrow Gauge News electronically.

The Society benefits from discounts on magazines sent to full members allowing us to use priority mail or airmail. Sadly, there are no mailing discounts for UK e-members and so there is only a small difference between the full membership and e-membership subscriptions.

How to renew your membership

Approximately a quarter of members pay their membership subscription by direct debit. If you renew this way, your payment will be taken on 1 April 2022 and you need take no further action.

If you do not renew by direct debit, but have provided us with a current email address, you should have seen a renewal email explaining how to renew your membership online by bank transfer, debit card, credit card or payment using a PayPal or Stripe account. Around half of all members now pay their annual subscription electronically.

If you did not receive a renewal email, you can still renew online if you have an email address associated with your membership record as below:-

Online payment using a debit card, credit card or PayPal / Stripe account. Please visit the Society website at www.ngrs.org/membership and click on the Renew button. This will take you to our Membermojo database where you need to insert the email address you have registered on your membership.

You can renew and pay your membership subscription by cheque using the renewal slip below. Your cheque should be made payable to "Narrow Gauge Railway Society" (drawn on a UK bank and payable in sterling).

Several members have asked if they can make a voluntary donation to the Society at the same time as they renew. Should you wish to make a voluntary donation you can do this either as part of your online renewal or your cheque payment.
